APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Must be a member of White Mountain Apache community; that is, a resident of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation or the child of a White Mountain Apache Tribe Member (preference for applicants who are members / citizens of recognized tribes)
- 2. Must have completed the equivalent of at least two terms of study (minimum 20 credit hours) at an accredited college or university with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater
- 3. Must have completed with a grade of "C" or greater (GPA 2.5) at least three courses or declared a major (or both) related to the internship
